

What does the color of your dog's poop mean?



Here are the potential different colors of dog poop and what they mean.



Brown
Normal and healthy



Green:
Possibly caused by a gall bladder issue or eating too much grass



Yellow or orange:
Could mean liver, pancreas, or gallbladder problems



Black:
Indicates bleeding in the upper GI tract caused by disease or something ingested



Grey or greasy:
Could be a problem with the pancreas



Bloody:
Could be caused by cuts in the anus or colon or several other conditions



Purple:
Purple poop is a sign of a life-threatening condition called hemorrhagic gastroenteritis



With white spots:
Indicates tapeworms or other parasites



Dog Poop Consistency

These are the different consistencies of dog poop and what they mean.



Soft but not runny:
This is considered healthy stool



Hard:
Hard pellets or hard stool might indicate your dog is suffering from constipation or dehydration



Runny/diarrhea:
Could mean liver, pancreas, or gallbladder problems
